

Rules of Play

Check In: Deadline for checking in is 30 min. prior to scheduled tee time. Anyone arriving after the dead line may be placed on a team ONLY if needed to complete an already existing 3 man team. When you arrive at the scheduled golf course first make sure your individual card is pulled and submitted to the Tournament of the Day Committee, consisting of the Chairman, Sec./Treasurer, Asst. Sec./Treasurer and/or their designated representatives. Entry fee will be collected at the time you turn in your card. Prior to the scheduled tee off time the Tournament of the Day Committee will announce the team pairings, any special rules for the day and what type of golf format we will play.

All players will play from the Senior Tees!

Rain Outs: The Tournament of the Day Committee will have the final say when and if a scheduled tournament will be cancelled.

Prizes: In all regular weekly tournaments prizes will be awarded to the teams with the lowest scores on the front, back and overall. In case of ties the prizes will be divided equally to the winning teams. If there are 28 or more players one team cannot win more than 2 sides. If a team has the best score on all 3 sides they will win 2 sides and the team with the second best overall score will win on one side. If there are 27 or less players one team can win all three sides.
